Tri-State Trail Vision is one of the 10 original envision 2010 committees with the mission of developing an integrated trail system to enhance the life of the residents in the Tri-State area.

What We've Done:

- Developed a trail and bike route plan for the tri-state area
- Provided input for the City of Dubuque's cost-feasibility study for a trail between Mines of Spain and Bergfeld park along the Middle fork of Catfish Creek
- Advocated for bike racks on city buses
- Advocated for implementation of the Complete Streets Initiative in Dubuque. A Complete Street is designed to enable safe access for all users: pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists and bus riders of all ages and abilities.

What We Can Do With Your Help:

- Facilitate local match funding for state and federal grant programs for projects like:
 - Building a Pedestrian Overpass across Hwy 52 for Heritage Trail
 - Adding a trail connecting Mines of Spain and Bergfeld park
- Advocate for additional amenities like bike racks, restrooms, drinking fountains, benches, etc. for existing and new trails.
